#### **Skater Qualifications:**

#### **CANSkate**

- -minimum of 4 years of age as of Jan 1, 2019
- -learn fundamentals of skating in preparation for figure skating, hockey, or recreational skating
- -45 minutes of group instruction; progress through stage 1-6
- -upon completion of Stage 3, skaters have the option to move into the Primary STARSkate program

#### **Primary STARSkate**

- -intro to figure skating; must have passed CANSkate Stage 3
- -sessions consist of a 15 min group lesson, 15 min stroking lesson, and 30 min free time to work independently or with a private coach

#### Intermediate STARSkate

-must have passed Stage 6 or Dutch Waltz

#### Senior STARSkate

-must have passed 2 of 3 – Junior Bronze Skills, Senior Bronze Dances or Prelim.freeskate; or adult skater
